CONTEXT MIAMI SUMMIT 2022 COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

January 4, 2022

We want to ensure that your Context Miami Summit 2022 experience is as safe as possible. In an effort to protect our community, we are proud to have chosen the JW Marriott Miami Turnberry Resort and Spa which provides a secluded campus for our clients. The venue's guests are almost exclusively made up of members of the Context 365 community. With the addition of this COVID-19 Health and Safety policy, we are doing everything we can to keep everyone as safe as possible at the Miami Summit.

Context adheres to all local health and safety guidelines as well as current restrictions on venue capacity. Enhanced cleaning protocols will be in place throughout the event, and outdoor space utilized when possible.

The pandemic creates an ever-evolving environment, therefore we will continue to monitor progress and may adapt our safety measures to respond to any changes to the COVID-19 landscape.

Presently, after considering industry practices and any requirements of the state of Florida, Miami-Dade County, and the JW Marriott Miami Turnberry Resort and Spa, Context's COVID-19 policy is:

Proof of Vaccination or Negative Test Result: Every attendee will be required to provide either (a) proof of COVID-19 vaccination (meaning at least 2 weeks have passed after a single-dose vaccine or after the second dose in a two-dose vaccine series), or (b) a negative COVID-19 test result where such test was taken 72 hours or less prior to entry to the Context Miami Summit 2022 event.

Context is partnering with SafeAccess to manage the reporting and verification of vaccination status and negative test results. SafeAccess (<https://www.safeaccess360.com>) is a leading solution provider that leverages a HIPAA-compliant secure platform. All data is kept private, not used for any non-event purposes, and can be deleted at any time. Submission of materials to SafeAccess is via a secure login that, for purposes of security and privacy, will be sent to each event attendee from no-reply@live.safeaccess.app or healthandsafety@live.safeaccess.app a couple of weeks prior to the event. No action is required from any event attendee until then.

Although SafeAccess will be onsite at the event registration to assist any attendees who have not submitted their materials in advance, attendees are strongly encouraged to submit their materials as far in advance as possible leading up to the event in order to streamline their on-site registration.

Context will not have access to any attendee medical information uploaded or submitted to SafeAccess. Context will simply know the output from SafeAccess, (i.e., whether an individual may attend or may not attend the event).

CONTEXT MIAMI SUMMIT 2022 COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Context's onsite vendors are subject to the same vaccination or negative testing requirements as all other event attendees.

Face Covering Policy: Masks will be required for all unvaccinated individuals except when outdoors or when eating or drinking. Masks are recommended for all vaccinated individuals except when outdoors or when eating or drinking. Masks must adequately cover the nose and mouth. Masks will be provided for all event attendees who do not have one.

Hotel Protocols: Throughout the event:

- the hotel will include signage recommending that all unvaccinated guests wear a mask
- hand sanitization stations will be made available for all attendees

Meals: Wherever possible, meals shall be served and enjoyed outside. Most outdoor eating areas are covered.

Personal Responsibility: We ask all attendees to monitor themselves for any symptoms of COVID-19 (please check the CDC website <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html> for a summary of such symptoms). If, prior to entering the event, you do not feel well, or are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, or have tested positive for COVID-19, please do not attempt to attend the event. If, during the event, you do not feel well, are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, or have tested positive for COVID-19, you must leave the event promptly. In the event you are positive for COVID-19 we strongly recommend you quarantine per CDC guidelines.
